Discovery Questions

The # of procedures needed. • Is this exact or estimated?

The # of lockout points per asset.

- Single lockout point asset?
- · Are there many that may be duplicate procedures for several assets?
- Multiple power sources per asset?
- · Multiple energy source types (electrical, mechanical, pneumatic, hydraulic, chemical, thermal, or other)?

Is there an identification system for your equipment already in place?

- · Numbering or labeling system to identify where each piece of equipment is located?
- OR would our team also be responsible for creating an identification process as we walk through? (document or spreadsheet)

How do you plan to implement procedures?

- Do you intend to receive procedures and attach them yourself?

Complexity of how we will reach equipment?

- · Is fall protection required for any assets? (i.e., scissor lifts, large equipment, multi-story processes, etc.).
- · Any extreme conditions where equipment is found? (i.e. extreme heat, extreme cold, acidic environments, etc.).
- Any specific PPE requirements to be on-site in production?

Would someone be available to walk through and describe current LOTO procedures?

- Dedicated Maintenance/Electrical/Engineering/Plant Manager or individual who can walk our team through the facility during the fact gathering.
- Individual would need to describe the asset procedure to shut down. Our team would transpose that process, include required information, images, LOTO equipment required, and complete the full procedure write-up back at office.

More complex questions.

- · Are there any assets that require alternate procedures?
 - i.e., advances in machine guarding (i.e., e-stops, light curtains) sometimes require an alternate procedure to be written and/or for routine maintenance tasks.
- Do you have any confined spaces? Do you have written procedures for them?
