Did you know OSHA offers a simple online safety learning product called eTools? eTools and the eMatrix are "stand-alone," interactive, web-based training tools on occupational safety and health topics. They are highly illustrated and utilize graphical menus. Some also use expert system modules, which enable the user to answer questions, and receive reliable advice on how OSHA regulations apply to their work site. Expert advisors are based solely on expert systems and v-Tools are prevention video training tools. Select eTools are available as downloadable files for offline use. While eTools doesn't cover all topics, they do offer over 50 categories.
