



Can Winter Liners be Worn Under Hard Hats?

This question has come up: Is it OSHA compliant for hard hat wearers to wear winter liners, or any skull cap or stocking hat under a hard hat? The answer is YES. Many of the manufacturers of hard hats support the wearing of tight fitting coverings over the head under the hard hat.

However, nothing should ever be put between the hard hat suspension and the shell itself. This is not approved by the manufacturer and can inhibit the performance of the hard hat, and cause injury.

All the liners and covers in our catalog are in compliance with manufacturer recommendation. You can also insert the Ergodyne N-Ferno warming packs in many of the liners. Most of these liners have Velcro tabs that help keep the hard hat more secure on the head and the liner in place when you take off the hat. Please note that only “ratchet suspension” style hard hats work well with liners (allowing the user to tighten the hat over the liner is important to keeping the hat secure on the head).

It's the season in those cold weather areas of the country for liners—our products are OSHA compliant.
